

## The Pearson Trophy - Inter-County Semi/Finals 18th July 2024

The 2023-24 Pearson Season culminated in the Semi-Finals and Final held in sunshine at Surrey's wonderful Hindhead Golf on the 18<sup>th</sup> of July 2024.

The Semi Final Matches were:

Birchwood Park (Kent) vs Hadley Wood (Herts) Roehampton (Surrey) vs Grim's Dyke (Middlesex)

Birchwood Park vs Hadley Wood was very closely fought, at the half way point Birchwood Park were up in three matches, down in two with the remining two all square. Hadley Wood rallied and eventually won the 1<sup>st</sup> Semi Final 4 games to 3.
